

Writing Process:

The writing process is a significant part of the language program where all writing is treated as a creative act which requires time and positive feedback. Since writing is a process that involves these distinct steps, it is a recursive process. Students use feedback to modify their work and have to return to the prewriting step to develop and expand their ideas.

Steps in this writing process include:

- **Prewriting:** Students brainstorm ideas, use a graphic organiser, create an outline, or use a writing prompt to get started.
- **Drafting:** Students write a first draft of the task using their prewritten plan as a guideline.
- **Revising and Editing:** Students revise their work to make it better by choosing more refined words or re-arranging sentence or the sequence of events. They edit their work by correcting errors in spelling, punctuation, and grammar.
- **Rewriting:** Students write a final draft that reflects their revisions and attention to detail.
- **Publishing:** Students present their work to others.





The Language Program



- Regular assessments to track language proficiency


The Book Plan


